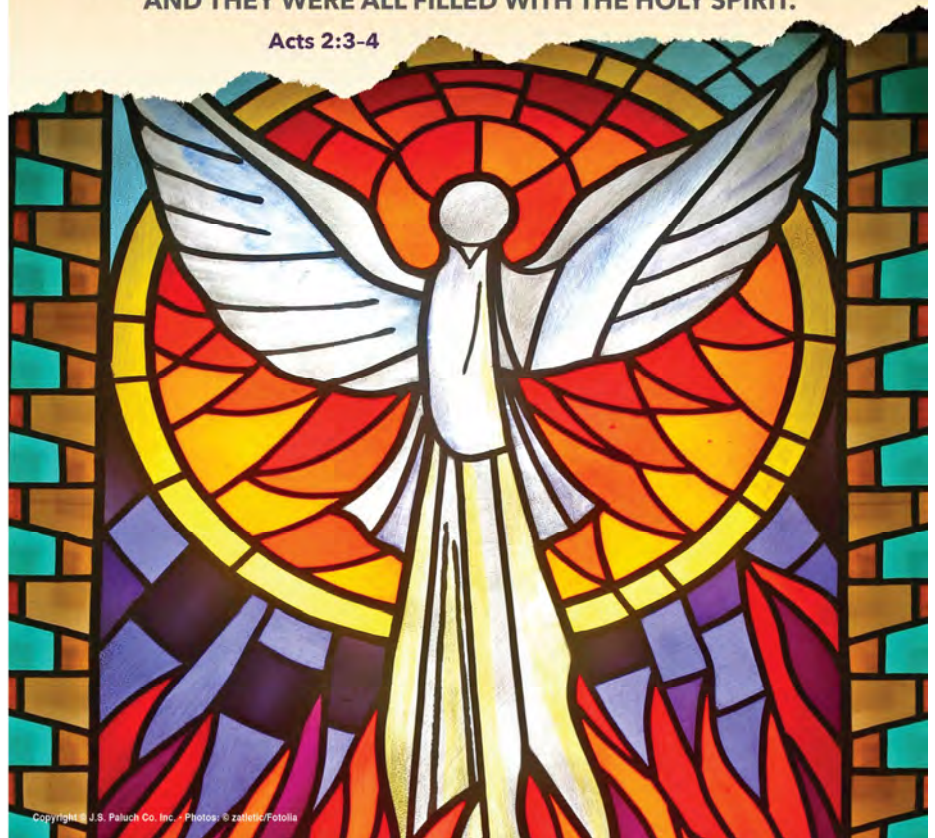

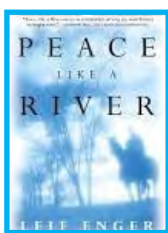

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. Pentecost is more than celebrating the “birthday” of the Church—it celebrates our “birth” into resurrection life and being sent to forgive others. 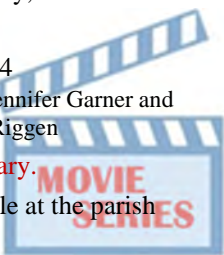
